ORDINANCE NO.

A GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI AMENDING CHAPTER 40-5, WATER RATES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Section 1. Section 40-5 of the Code of the City of Nevada, Missouri, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) A commercial building with more than one occupant (i.e., office buildings, stores, shops, etc.) may be served with one street service connection when under one ownership and the owner or manager is responsible for payment of the water bill, and it is not prorated among the occupants.
- (b) A building or group of buildings used for industrial purposes under one ownership and occupied by a single firm, may be served by a single street service connection.
- (c) Tourist courts, trailer parks and institutional buildings will be located on a single street service connection.
- (d) All contracts for water service shall be subject to all rules and regulations heretofore or hereafter adopted or promulgated by the city water department, and all applicable ordinances of the city which may be now or hereafter in force.
- (e) All applicants for water service shall sign in advance, at the time of planning or starting of construction such form of contracts for service as may be acceptable to the city.
- (f) City water will not supply water service until the customer's application for service has been approved by the city, and until the city finds it practicable to render such service.
- (g) Any change in the identity of the contracting customer at a premises shall require a new application and the city water department may discontinue the water supply until such new application has been made and accepted by the city.
- (h) All water piping and equipment on the customer's premises shall comply with the plumbing code of the city.
- (i) This section to be repealed.
