Arrest Warrants Served in Burglary Case
Nevada, Missouri

Nevada Police report that they have made two arrests in conjunction with a burglary investigation which began on September 16th when the owner of a residence in the 200 block of E. Floral Street reported an unlawful entry into her residence.

Responding officers were called to the residence where the victim reported the theft of jewelry and other personal items valued in excess of \$1000 dollars. Entry had been made through an unsecured rear bedroom window.

During the course of the investigation Nevada Police Officers were able to recover property and establish evidence leading to the issuance of Felony arrest warrants for two City of Nevada residents.

Felony Warrants for Receiving Stolen Property were issued by the Vernon County Associate Circuit Court on:

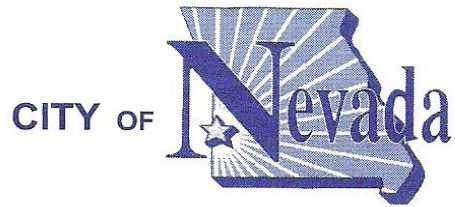
1. Tiffany L. Arnold, 29 years old
