Arrest Warrants Served in Burglary Case
Nevada, Missouri

Nevada Police report that they have concluded an investigation into a burglary investigation which began on June 24th when the owner of an auto sales lot in the 1400 block of W. Austin reported an unlawful entry into his business.

Responding officers were called to the business address where the victim reported the theft of hand and power tools valued in excess of \$3,500.

Relying on a tip from a reliable citizen, Nevada Police Detectives developed evidence that led to the recovery of a significant amount of property and obtained felony warrants against two Vernon County residents.

Warrants for Burglary 2nd Degree were issued by the Vernon County Associate Circuit Court which led to the arrest of:

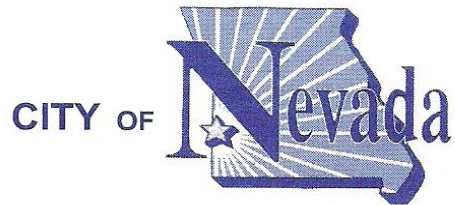
Jeramie S. West, 35 years old
