**Arrest Warrants Issued in Burglary Case**

Nevada Police report that they have concluded an investigation into a Burglary that occurred in the 500 block of W Allison during the week of May 27<sup>th</sup>.

Police report that the residential dwelling was burglarized and several items of property were stolen, including a .32 semi automatic pistol.

Investigating Officers determined that the suspect forced entry through a basement door and gained access to the main portion of the home. After analyzing evidence at the scene, police were able to identify a suspect.
