Arrest Warrants Served in Burglary Case
Nevada, Missouri

Nevada Police report that they have concluded an investigation into a burglary investigation which began on August 7th when the owner of a residence in the 400 block of S. Washington Street reported an unlawful entry into his residence.

Responding officers were called to the residence where the victim reported the theft of currency and other personal items valued in excess of \$500 dollars.

During the course of the investigation Nevada Officers were able to identify and establish evidence leading to the issuance of Felony arrest warrants for two City of Nevada residents.

Warrants for Burglary 2nd Degree were issued by the Vernon County Associate Circuit Court which led to the arrest of:

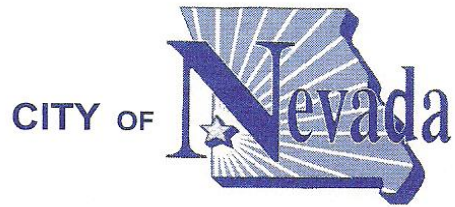
Kyle Crawford, 21 years old
