**Arrest Made on Wanted Person**  
**Nevada, Missouri**

Nevada Police report that they have apprehended an individual that had several warrants on file for his arrest.

The original incident occurred while officers were working a drug surveillance in the 600 block of E Hickory. Nevada Police Officer Lukas Gibson observed an individual known to police walking into the surveillance area. Officer Gibson knew the male subject was wanted under several warrants for his arrest and confronted the subject. When contacted, the individual fled on foot with Officer Gibson in pursuit. The police were aided by a concerned citizen in the pursuit and successfully took the wanted subject into custody.

The arrest warrants executed included Domestic Assault, Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Felony Probation Violation. During a search incident to the arrest officers located a substance believed to be a controlled substance.

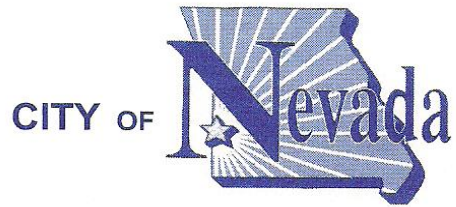
The successful arrest was made on a 23 year, Nevada resident:
