Warrants Issued in Assault with Knife
Nevada, Missouri

Nevada Police report that they have concluded an investigation into a reported assault case where the suspect challenged the victim to fight and brandished a knife.

The incident was reported to police on June 26, 2012 at about 11:25pm as a disturbance on the parking lot of a business located in the 700 block of N Osage.

Upon arrival at the scene, the police identified a wanted suspect with the aid of several witnesses remaining at the scene of the disturbance. The suspect reportedly fled when he realized that police were called. Nevada Police began a search and a short time later located the wanted subject in the 600 block of N. Prewitt and executed an arrest. When placed under arrest, a knife was located on his person and seized incident to that arrest.

Several witnesses came forward to aid the police in this investigation.

Nevada Police arrested a 29 year old Moundville resident, identified as:
