**Arrest Made in Burglary**  
**Nevada, Missouri**

Nevada Police report that they have concluded an investigation into a reported burglary that occurred in the 1000 block of E. Nicholson.

Police determined that the crime took place on the weekend of May 12-14 and was reported to authorities after the crime was discovered by a relative of the property owner. The apparent entry point into the home was made by breaking a window at the rear of the house. Reported stolen was a flat screen TV, a toaster and various tools.

Investigating officers processed the crime scene and recovered several items of physical evidence, including suspect latent fingerprints. Lab analysis of that evidence led to the arrest of a 29 year old Nevada resident identified as:

Felony warrants were issued by the Vernon County Associate Circuit Court on the following charges:

Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> degree                      C Felony                      \$5,000 Cash Bond

Williams remains in custody at the Vernon County Jail on this and other unrelated charges. A second suspect continues to be sought by police.
