ORDINANCE NO. 8521

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI APPROPRIATING FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND EXPENDITURES FOR PURPOSES THAT FULFILL THE INTENT OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH.

Whereas, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 11, 2021; and,

Whereas, the City of Nevada is estimated to receive \$1,660,000 pain in two installments of \$833,475.30 with the first payment received on August 27, 2021 and the second payment to be made no earlier than 12 months after the date on which the first payment is made; and,

Whereas, ARPA funds may be used for Public Health Initiatives according to the U.S. Department of the Treasury's final rule for State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI THAT:


Section 1. The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) fund balance of \$833,475.30 shall reduce by a not to exceed amount of \$100,000.00 for the purpose of funding the City Convalescent Home's Public Health Initiatives.


Section 2. To respond to the negative health and economic impact during COVID-19 public health emergency, the following expenditures described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, are approved.

Section 3. The City Manager and City Treasurer are hereby directed and authorized to make the appropriate notations in the budget documents and transfer funds so as to reflect the above changes.
