Ash Street, Nevada, Missouri 64772, and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work includes the following: Construction and installation of 2,908 linear feet of concrete sidewalk including ADA ramps and landings, and concrete approaches. The work also includes associated earthwork, placement of aggregate base, traffic control, erosion and sediment control measures, and all incidental work necessary to complete the project as shown in the plans.
