Subject: Muzzleloaders Black Powder Competition

Department: Parks and Recreation

The Missouri Osage Territory Muzzleloaders has partnered with the Nevada Parks and Recreation Department for the past several years to host an outdoor classroom and sanctioned Missouri Offhand shooting competition. The competition has taken place at Marmaduke Park.

This year's competition is scheduled for September 12, 13, 14, and 15, 2013 contingent upon approval by the City Council. The Park Board reviewed the request at its May 29th meeting and voted to send a positive recommendation to Council to waive the provisions of Section 23-26, discharge of firearms, and Section 2-23, closing hours of the parks, of the City Code for the Muzzleloaders.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING A WAIVER FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 23-26, DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND SECTION 2-23, CLOSING HOURS OF THE PARKS OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MISSOURI OSAGE TERRITORY MUZZLELOADERS BLACK POWDER COMPETITION TO BE HELD SEPTEMBER 12, 13, 14, AND 15, 2013 AT MARMADUKE PARK

WHEREAS, The Missouri Osage Territory Muzzleloaders has scheduled a black powder shooting competition to be held on September 12, 13, 14, and 15, 2013 at Marmaduke Park; and

WHEREAS, These competitions would involve the use of shotguns, black powder rifles, trade guns, and pistols, and;

WHEREAS, The participants of this event desire to stay overnight in Marmaduke Park during the competition week-end and;

WHEREAS, It is the desire of City Council to waive the provisions of the Code of the City of Nevada, Missouri to allow the Missouri Osage Territory Muzzleloaders to hold this event in Marmaduke Park on September 12, 13, 14, and 15, 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri, that provisions of Section 23-26 and Section 2-23 of the Code of the City of Nevada are hereby waived and the Missouri Osage Territory Muzzleloaders are hereby authorized to conduct a black powder competition and stay overnight in Marmaduke Park on September 12, 13, 14, and 15, 2013.
